

Abstract Submission Guidelines

We would like to thank for considering to submit your abstract to the 10th congress of the Association of Emergency Medicine. We are inviting international abstracts in English and German to be presented at our congress in 2022. To facilitate the submission process, we ask you to follow the guidelines as stated below.

1. Subject area and scientific field of abstract

Only abstracts are accepted for presentation at the congress that have a distinct connection to either pre-hospital emergency medicine, in-hospital emergency medicine, mass casualty management, disaster medicine or disaster management. Work from basic research, clinical studies, training/education research, quality management and case reports can be submitted in abstract form. Please state the respective subject area and scientific field on the abstract form.

2. Abstract format and length

Please follow the below stated guidelines to allow editing and print of your submitted abstract:

Font and line spacing: Arial, 11 pt, single spaced, no additional paragraph spacing, no indentation; numbering or other uniform enumerations are permitted (1 level)

Figures and tables are not permitted.

2.1. Title: Maximum 80 characters (not in capital letters)

2.2. Authors: Maximum 6 authors (First and last name in full, no titles), affiliations attributed by superscript numbering at the end of name (Example: Jane Scientist¹, John Researcher²)

2.3. Affiliations: Superscript numbering at the beginning of name; institution, superior organizational unit (optional), place (Example: ¹Institute for Research, University of Science, Vienna)

2.4. Word limit: Maximum 280 words

2.5. Abstract structure

- – Research question
- – Methodology
- – Results
- – Interpretation
- – Case reports can deviate from this structure

Please create abstract structure headings not as independent headings.

Please give headings in bold at the beginning of the respective paragraph.

2.6. References: State references in text in square brackets in order of appearance in abstract.

3. Principals of the Helsinki-Declaration, declaration of Conflict of Interest (COI) and funding sources

We ask you to adhere to the following as applicable:

- Follow the principals of the Helsinki-Declaration; provide information on ethical review commission discussions or comparable institutions in your submitted abstract
- Declare all potential Conflict of Interests or the absence of them and state the received financial support in the abstract form. The signed abstract form must be submitted until March 15, 2022, to kongress@agn.at

4. Submission

Please send an e-mail (subject: Abstract AGN 2022) with your abstract form attached to kongress@agn.at and save the attached abstract form as *lastname.abstractkeyword.agn2022.doc(x)*. Only abstracts with complete personal information can be accepted.

The abstract submission period ends on **March 15, 2022!** Abstracts that are submitted later will automatically be rejected.
